

EARLY VOTING IS HERE!

Early **IN-PERSON** Voting is available to NJ Voters.

Q. When does early voting begin?

A. Early voting begins **Saturday, Oct. 29 – Sunday, Nov. 6.**

Monday thru Saturday, 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. and Sunday, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Q. Where do I go to vote early?

A. There are **THREE** designated “Vote Centers” available to Sussex County Voters.

- Sussex-Wantage Branch Library, Wantage
- Louise Childs Branch Library, Stanhope
- Cochran House, Newton

Q. If I choose to vote early in person, will I be using a machine?

A. YES. If you vote early in person, you will be using a voting machine (the same equipment used on Election Day (November 8)).

Q. Will I receive a Sample Ballot before the early voting period begins?

A. Yes, registered voters will receive a Sample Ballot in the mail 10-13 days before Election Day, which will provide address information for the Vote Centers, as well as voting hours

Q. If I am scheduled to receive a mail-in-ballot (MIB) will I be able to vote early in person?

A. NO. If you are scheduled to receive a mail-in ballot, you will **NOT** be able to use a voting machine **unless you first opt out of vote-by-mail** or vote *provisionally at your polling location.

KEEP READING...

IMPORTANT: Once the MIB's have been mailed (45 days prior to election), your opt out request will commence with the ***following*** election.

Example: The 2022 General Election MIB's were mailed September 24, 2022. Any opt out requests received after the above date *will be processed for the following election.*
